### PLEASE READ - GENERAL RULES

1.<u>ALL ENTRY</u> fees and blanks must be postmarked no later than Sept. 8, 2022 or hand delivered only to the Secretaries (address on back) by Saturday, Sept. 10<sup>th</sup>. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT NEW TOWN & COUNTRY STABLES. MUST BE MAILED OR DELIVERED TO SECRETARY.

- 2. NO PERSONAL CHECKS Money Orders or Cash Only. Make payable to T&C Rodeo Contestants.
- 3. <u>\$10.00 FINE PER MISTAKE OR LAST MINUTE CHANGES</u> on this entry form. All fines to be paid before contestant's number will be given. Late fees of \$40.00 if not postmarked or hand delivered by due dates.
- 4. <u>NUMBERS</u> will be given out on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>Sept. 28</u>, <u>2022</u> from 5:00 7:00 p.m. <u>ALL CONTESTANTS MUST PICK UP THEIR NUMBERS AT THIS TIME</u>. If you cannot be there, have someone pick up your number for you. All monies owed must be paid in full before receiving your number.
- 5. <u>CONTESTANTS</u>: Your number is your ticket to enter the grounds. No one will be allowed to enter without their number or a ticket. Tickets for contestants may be purchased at a reduced rate Wednesday evening only. Limited to maximum of 4 tickets per perf per contestant. Any misconduct by contestant or family member, at the admission gate or anywhere on Rodeo grounds will be treated the same as the arena rules and will result in disqualification of all contestants involved, forfeiture of any money won and eviction. No outside alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs allowed in or around contestant parking or anywhere on rodeo premises.

#### 6. ALL PAY OFFS WILL BE MAILED TO WINNERS AFTER THE RODEO HAS BEEN FINALIZED.

- 7. A CONTESTANT MAY NOT leave his partners name blank. If partner does not enter, management reserves the right to team up any unmatched partners and a fee of \$20.00 will be assessed for each partner. If a match is not possible by management, the contestant forfeits entry fees for that team.
- **8.** <u>A "NO TIME"</u> will be given to any contestant that injures an animal. Any roughing of cattle or schooling or beating a horse in or around the arena will also merit a "no time." Flipping or dragging of cattle will result in a "no time." Heel horse that is not in the back of the Heel Box when the steer leaves the chute will merit a "no time"
- 9. <u>ALL ROPERS AND RIDERS</u> must be ready to compete when called. If a contestant is not ready when called, their stock will be turned out and a disqualification given. Timed event contestants must be in the box when the animal prior to your run has entered the catch pen gate. Barrel Racers and Match Barrels must be ready at the gate when called or forfeit race.
- 10. ALL ROPERS: Each contestant will have three (3) chances to set your horse in the box, after the third try your steer will be turned out.
- 11. REFUNDS: There are no refunds.
- 12. MINORS: May be asked to show proof of age. Parent or Legal Guardian must sign entry blank!
- 13. DOUBLE MUGGING AND BREAKAWAY ROPING: Rope must pass over animal's head for a legal catch. Breakaway Ropers will be provided with strings.
- 14. TIMED EVENTS: No re-runs will be given if electric timer malfunctions. Back up timer will be used.
- 15. STABLING: Stalls are available by reservation with a 50% non-refundable deposit by calling 259-9941. \$30.00 per day. You must feed and supply own feed/bedding.
- 16. <u>ADMISSION AND PARKING</u>: Please come early to avoid congestion at the gate. Gates will open 2 hours before the start of each performance. ALL ADMISSION IS BY TICKET OR YOUR NUMBER ONLY. ALL trucks and trailers will be stopped at the driveway to collect or purchase additional tickets. <u>REMEMBER LIMITED PARKING IS AVAILABLE</u>. ENTRY INTO RODEO DOES NOT GUARANTEE PARKING IF ARRIVING LATE. NO ALCOHOL IN PARKING AREA.

#### \*\*\*CONDUCT RULES\*\*\*

- 1. ANY QUARRELING or fighting at any time on New & Country premises involving a contestant with rodeo officials, spectators, contestants, rodeo volunteers or any person involved with the management or operation of the rodeo or auxiliaries, such as the vendors, food booth and admission gate, also <u>ANY CONTESTANTS</u>, <u>FRIENDS AND/ OR FAMILY MEMBERS, THAT SPEAKS TO, APPROACHES, OR TRIES TO INTIMIDATE ANY JUDGE OR OFFICIAL ON BEHALF OF A CONTESTANT OR THEMSELVES DURING A RODEO PERFORMANCE, SLACK, OR ANYTIME ON RODEO PREMISES, WILL RESULT IN <u>IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION AND FORFEITURE OF ENTRY FEES AND ANY MONEY WON AND EVICTION FROM PREMISES</u>.</u>
- 2. ANY DRINKING of alcoholic beverages or taking of illegal drugs anywhere on rodeo grounds, including bleachers and contestant parking, before, during or after each performance will result in disqualification from the entire rodeo. Any and all money won will be forfeited. Teamed events next team will move up.
- 3. ALL DECISIONS made by the Arena Director regarding a rule decision will be final.
- 4. NO OUTSIDE food or drinks allowed in the bleacher area. No coolers in bleacher area.

### **DRESS RULES**

- 1. COWBOY HATS and long sleeve shirts with collars must be worn while contesting in and around the arena. Anyone helping to pull down the rough stock riders must be dressed accordingly or risk disqualifying the rider involved. Ball caps are not allowed.
- 2. NUMBERS are to be worn and clearly visible on the contestants back only.
- 3. IN ROUGH STOCK events only the sleeve of the riding arm may be rolled up.
- 4. ANY CONTESTANT entering the arena without complying with the dress rules will be disqualified from the rodeo and forfeit all money won.
- 5. ALL TEAM ROPERS AND WAHINE BARREL RACERS AND ALL OTHER TIMED EVENTS HATS there will be a no time if you lose your hat at any time during your run. DOUBLE MUGGING AND KEIKI BARRELS EXCLUDED.

### **SPECIAL AWARDS**

- 1. CHAMPIONSHIP BUCKLES will be awarded for each event. Winners will need to be present during the last performance for presentation of the buckles following the Sunday performance in the arena for sponsor photos and the winners run during the performance.
- 2. TIM KUHLMAN SPORTSMANSHIP BUCKLE will be awarded to anyone involved as a contestant, groom, official, worker, or volunteer who best exemplifies sportsmanship and the love of rodeo.
- 3. BEST DRESSED COWGIRL BUCKLE will be awarded to the cowgirl who has not only presented a well put together wardrobe for horse and rider throughout the rodeo but has exhibited skill, grit and a cowgirl-up attitude during competition. Must be present to win during last performance and dressed as Best Dressed Cowgirl to win.
- 4. ALL AROUND COWBOY: All Around Cowboy must win money in 2 or more events of which 1 to be a rough stock event, (double mugging is a rough stock event)
- **<u>5. ALL AROUND COWGIRL</u>**; Any event the Cowgirl is qualified to enter counts towards the All Around.

#### **RODEO WAIVER**

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, UNDERSTAND THAT HAWAIII LAW (Chapter 663B, Hawaii Revised Statutes) LIMITS THE CIVIL LIABILITY OF PERSONS OFFERING RODEO TYPE ACTIVITIES. I UNDERSTAND THAT THERE ARE INHERENT RISKS OF INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, WHEN PARTICIPATING WITH AND RIDING HORSES AND/OR BULLS AND BEING AROUND OTHER LIVESTOCK, SUCH AS CATTLE.
