WAIVER TERI HOOKANO MEMORIAL ROPING (THMR)

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, UNDERSTAND THAT HAWAII LAW (Chapter 663B, Hawaii Revised Statutes) LIMITS THE CIVIL LIABILITY OF PERSONS OFFERING EQUINE TYPE ACTIVITIES. I UNDERSTAND THAT THERE ARE INHERENT RISKS OF INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, WHEN PARTICIPATING WITH AND RIDING HORSES AND BEING AROUND OTHER LIVESTOCK, SUCH AS CATTLE INCLUDED BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO INJURY OR DEATH TO PERSON ON OR AROUND IT, HAZARDS SUCH AS SURFACE AND SUBSURFACE CONDITIONS. COLLISIONS WITH OTHER OBJECTS AND ANIMALS, THE UNPREDICTABILITY OF A HORSE OR CATTLE REACTION TO SUCH THINGS AS SOUNDS, SUDDEN MOVEMENT, UNFAMILIAR OBJECTS, PERSONS, OR OTHER ANIMALS AND THE POTENTIAL NEGLIGENCE OF ANOTHER PARTICIPANT, SUCH AS FAILING TO MAINTAIN CONTROL OVER THEIR HORSE OR NOT ACTING WITHIN THEIR ABILITY. KNOWING AND UNDERSTANDING THE RISKS OF RIDING AND PARTICIPATING WITH HORSES, CATTLE, BULLS, SHEEP AND ANY AND ALL LIVESTOCK, INCLUDING INJURY AND DEATH TO MY PERSON, DAMAGE TO MY PERSONAL PROPERTY, AND ANY AND ALL MEDICAL EXPENSES I MAY INCUR, I EXPRESSLY CHOOSE TO ACKNOWLEDGE AND ASSUME THESE RISKS. I AM PRESENTLY IN GOOD PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH AND I AM NOT UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS AND/OR ALCOHOL. I AGREE THAT I WILL NOT BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL WHILE PARTICIPATING IN THIS EVENT OR ANYWHERE ON THE EVENT GROUNDS OR RISK DISQUALIFICATION AND FOREFEITURE OF ALL MONIES WON. I UNDERSTAND THAT NO ALCOHOL BEVERAGES OR ILLEGAL DRUGS ARE ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE EVENT GROUNDS INCLUDING PARKING. I HEREBY WAIVE AND RELEASE ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS AND CAUSES OF ACTION AGAINST KUALOA RANCH HAWAII, INC., LAZY L RANCH, TERRY NII, DIAMOND T LIVESTOCK, GIMA PEST CONTROL, INC., DAVID & SHARON SUNAGAWA, JOSEPH HOOKANO Jr, JOSEPH HOOKANO III, JUDY MIURA, CAROLYN TANABE, THEIR HEIRS AND SUCCESSORS, ANY AND ALL ENTITIES, ANY AND ALL WORKERS, SPECTATOR'S OR VOLUNTEERS WORKING AT THIS EVENT, FOR ANY DAMAGE, INJURY OR INJURY RESULTING IN DEATH TO THE UNDERSIGNED, RESULTING FROM THE UNDERSIGNED'S PARTICIPATION IN THESE EVENTS. IF THE UNDERSIGNED IS THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF ANY MINOR PARTICIPATING, THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS FROM ANY CLAIMS, INJURIES, DAMAGES AND CAUSES OF ACTION BROUGHT BY OR ON BEHALF OF SUCH MINOR AT ANY TIME. THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES THAT THIS INSTRUMENT IS A LEGAL CONTRACT AND IS BINDING ON HIS/HER HEIRS AND ASSIGNS. I ALSO AGREE TO ABIDE BY ALL RULES SET FORTH CONCERNING THE TERI HOOKANO MEMORIAL ROPING EVENTS AND UNDERSTAND THAT THIS WAIVER AND INDEMNITY COVERS ANY PRACTICE SESSIONS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE TERI HOOKANO MEMORIAL ROPING EVENT. I ALSO AGREE TO RELEASE ALL RIGHTS OF IMAGES ON MYSELF RESULTING FROM PHOTOGRAPHS OR VIDEO IN THESE EVENTS TO BE USED FOR PROMOTIONAL PURPOSES.

Teri Hookano Memorial Roping (THMR) RULES

1. To be qualified to rope at Terry Hookano Memorial Roping (THMR) participants must accept and sign the rules of the THMR Event and Waiver. Entries must be submitted by mail to: Carolyn Tanabe, PO Box 1952, Pearl City, HI 96782 and post marked by Friday, May 24, or hand delivered to: Carolyn Tanabe by 5pm, Saturday May 25. **Acceptance of your entry is based on a first come first served basis. Roping Sign in 7:30am. Roping Starts approximately 8:30am on June 22, 2024.**
2. **Payment must be made in full and accompany entry.** If payment is not received with entry, late fees of \$100 may be due, if we do not receive payment in a timely manner, your teams including your partners teams may be forfeited. (refund will be given to partner if they paid).
3. Flagman/Arena Director Decision is final. Roping Committee, Arena Director or Flagman has the right to change the format and rules of the event BEFORE the roping starts.
4. **Any unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. There will be no negative comments, grumbling, fighting or threats made to the Flagman, Arena Director, Event Volunteers, Participants or Spectators before, during and after the event. (Fighting or Threats will be considered as Terroristic Threatening and the proper authorities (Police) will be summoned. Any prizes due to the roper will be forfeited because of the infractions stated above. Prizes will be awarded to the next qualified participant. THERE WILL BE NO CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL OR ILLICIT DRUGS BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE MEMORIAL EVENT**
5. **It is the ropers responsibility to call Robert Rita 808-479-9353 for their roping classification number.**
6. For team roping - #3.5 Roping will be capped at #2 roper (Both ends – Header & Heeler)
#4.5 Roping will be capped at #3.5 Roper (Both ends – Header & Heeler)
7. For Girls 4D Breakway Roping there will be a 2.5 cap.
8. There will be a 5 second SLIDE splits in the Girls 4D Breakway.
9. Two loops can be thrown for the Girls Breakaway as long as the roper is carrying two ropes. There will be no rebuilding of loops
10. In the #7 & #4.5 & #3.5 ropings there will be a four partner limit. #7 will have a six partner limit. Additional teams may be added depending on the number of participants or teams. Addition of additional teams will be based on a first come first served basis. Notices of additional teams needed will be posted on social media.
11. 4D Girls Breakaway will have only one go. Only one entry per roper.
12. #7 & # 4.5 will have one go with top fifteen fastest teams coming back for short go.
#3.5 Roping and 4D Breakaway will be one go only.
13. There will be no monetary refunds for no shows and disqualifications.
14. 4D Breakaway Ropers can only enter one time.
15. The catch pen will be open for the #7 & #4.5 Roping Events.
16. The catch pen will be closed for the Breakaway, #3.5 Ropings
17. It will be the responsibility of all ropers to make sure that the catch pen is set, arena is clear of the previous steer and the flagman is ready.
18. There will be a time limit of one minute to catch your steer in the #7, 4.5 & 3.5 Ropings.
Breakaway will be 45 Seconds.
19. There will be a draw for the line up to rope in the roping and breakaway events.

20. For Team Roping one loop at each end, three legal head catches (around the neck, around the horns or half-head (around the neck less one horn).
21. Reruns for the ropings will be determined by the Flagman/Arena Director. The logistics of the rerun will determined by the Flagman/Arena Director.
22. For 4D Breakaway Roping a clean catch is considered when the ropers loop goes through the steers HEAD and catches any part of the steers body including the tail.
23. Headers must stay dallied and face to receive a flag.
24. If a rope is caught on any moving part of the chute, the team will get a clean steer at the end of the go.
25. Crossfire – The heel rope cannot come in contact with the steers legs until BOTH:
 - a. The header has control of the steer’s head
 - b. And the steer’s hips have changes direction, with the steer having forward motion.
26. There will be a 5 second penalty if heeler catches only one leg in the #3.5, #4.5 & #7.5
27. There will be a 5 second penalty for a broken barrier in the #3.5, 4.5 and 7.
10 second penalty for a broken barrier in the breakaway.
28. All female heelers and heelers 50 years of age or older may tie on hard & fast.
29. Any malfunction of the clocks will warrant a clean steer at the end of the go only if a qualified run was made.
30. If the flagger says of his/her own accord that he/she made a mistake or awards the team another steer, the team will get a clean steer at the end of the go.
31. Any questions about the time, flag, equipment malfunction or steer need to be settled before the next team ropes.
32. There will be no interference calls. It is the team’s responsibility to have the arena cleared and flagman ready before they call for a steer. In the effort to save time, ropers may be in the arena if they are scheduled to rope in that event. Ropers are to be mounted on their horse between the Event Director and Arena Entrance. No tying of unmounted horses in the arena.
33. Time is of the essence in the THMR. We will not be waiting for ropers for any reason. Ropers must be ready to rope and in the roping box when called. The next roper to rope must be waiting by the arena entrance or in the arena. There will be a 3 call rule limit spaced about every 10 seconds. At the third call the steer will be released.
34. All ties will be settled by a rope off or flip of a coin or in case of more than two ties per event, arena director will decide on the how the winner(s) will be settled.
35. Any abuse of horses or steers at the THMR will be a no time and/or disqualification from the ropings. Any unsportsmanlike behavior or language may result in the same actions. Flagger’s decision and/or director’s decision are final.
36. Dress code is western attire, long or short sleeve western shirt OR event t-shirt. Cowboy hat, ball cap or no hat. Cowboy boots. Ropers will be disqualified from the event if any attire that appears be offensive or demeans the integrity of the THMR event.
37. Payouts and Event Prizes will be determined by the Event Secretary. Payouts will be mailed after the event within two weeks of the completion of the event
38. Prizes will be as follows:

3rd Place Buckles and Money
#5 Incentive Team Buckles

#4.5 Roping – 1st to 3rd Place – Buckles and Money

4D Girls Breakaway Roping

- Saddle for the roper with the fastest time

- Buckles for fastest times of each D.

Bounty Steer Team – Buckles to the Bounty Steer Team if the team

makes a qualified catch in the #3.5, #4.5 & #7

Lucky Saddle Giveaway – given to person with winning giveaway ticket.

- #3.5, #3 Incentive, & Girls 4D Breakaway Saddle winners not eligible for Giveaway Saddle
- Must be contestant to be eligible for Giveaway Saddle
- Contestant must be present during the time of the drawing to receive giveaway saddle.

39. All questions/Comments regarding the THMR roping events by the contestants, parent/guardian, volunteers, spectators must be addressed before the start of the THMR Event.

40. Additional add on team (If any) payments will be due in cash ONLY at sign in before start of the first event on the day of the roping. Add on teams for the roping events will be based on a first come first served served bases.

41. All reruns determined by the flagman.

42. No Duplicate teams (No switching of ends)

43. Ropers may have a horse or person in the box to assist at their own risk.
